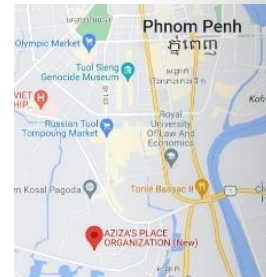

Our First Generation Beneficiaries (20+) have all grown into responsible young men and women, speaking fluent English, holding well-paying jobs, taking care of themselves and their families, including parents.

The Second Generation includes nine (9) of our current Beneficiaries in Secondary and High School and finding their way.

The Third Generation includes a large cohort of 29 children in Primary School posing us the challenge to secure funding enabling us to support them through completion of High School (Grade 12).
