Aziza's Place was founded on 14 February 2007 in honor of the memory of Aziza Ghori to address a heartfelt need to help children, especially girls, and their families offering caring, holistic, and effective opportunities and support.

Our Founding Vision was shaped by years of volunteering at NGOs in Phnom Penh where too many organizations prioritized short term metrics for "success" at the expense of their Beneficiaries.

Our vision is much longer term, to deliver generational impact in programs that transform outcomes for Beneficiary children and their families, to help them build lives out of the confines of poverty.

## OUR BENEFICIARIES

Our First Generation Beneficiaries (20+) have all grown into responsible young men and women, speaking fluent English, holding well-paying jobs, taking care of themselves and generations in their families, working for their communities, and mentoring our younger generations.

Our Second Generation includes nine (9) current Beneficiaries in Secondary and High School, each a promising profile in success.

The Third Generation includes a cohort of 29 children in Primary School, our focus to secure funding to support them through High School (Grade 12).



## OUR PROGRAMS

### HEALTH

- Comprehensive health insurance plan
- Weekly GP visits for health monitoring
- Regular ear, eyes and dental check-ups

### NUTRITION

- Two nourishing meals per day, six days a week
- Healthy snacks, fresh fruit, juices/ water always available

### SOCIAL WORK

- Regular meetings with families to hear concerns and find solutions
- Building links between families and the schools the children attend

### EDUCATION

- Cover school fees and all school related expenses.
- Tutoring support
- English and digital literacy classes

### SPORTS

- Weekly Karate lessons, competition mentoring
- Weekly supervised skateboarding

- Weekly traditional “Khmer Dance Class”
- Different art projects
