Supporting 32 Families through the Covid-19 Pandemic....





Family Assemby for Distribution of Provisions

As soon as the Cambodian Government announced measures designed to stop the spread of COVID-19 and all schools were required to close, Aziza's Place convened an emergency family assembly in mid-March to inform parents of the situation and to confirm our plan to continue supporting them throughout the suspension of AP center activities. An unfortunate repercussion of the Coronavirus means that parents and guardians have the added burden of trying to support their children's learning, health and well-being while struggling to make ends meet. By implementing the following activities, Aziza's Place hopes to alleviate at least a small portion of the additional hardship that our 32 families are facing.

- Initiated a meal package delivery project, as of April 20th;
- Organized home learning activities for all our Beneficiary children;
- Continued to provide the monthly basic support package, including additional provisions of hygiene supplies; and,
- Facilitated the distribution of supplies from individual donors to beneficiaries.



Meal Packs Program

To serve our communities and keep our staff engaged throughout the Covid-19 crisis, AP has implemented a meal delivery program, which provides for one meal per day, five days per week for our 50 beneficiary children and their families. Our chef and house mom prepare a food package consisting of highly nutritional meals along with a snack (fruit, juice, milk) that is then delivered by our staff to beneficiaries. AP is especially thankful to WIG Cambodia and former volunteers Joe Evans and Merle Streck, for their generous financial contributions that have made this program a reality.

Homework Assignments

Amidst school closures throughout Cambodia, AP wanted to ensure that our Beneficiary children remain academically engaged and asked our tutors to create a set of learning exercises for the



children to work on during the week.

The "remote" lessons and learning activities in Khmer Language/Math,

English and Art, are dropped of with the children at the start of each week by our resident social worker, Marady and the completed assignments are then collected at the end of the week for the tutors to correct and mark and track the children's progress.

Facilitating Donations by Individuals

Given our daily contact (taking all the necessary safety precautions) with our Beneficiary children and their families, AP is also acting as a conduit for the delivery of vital provisions and hygiene products donated by concerned supporters and friends of Aziza's Place for distribution in the Communities where our Beneficiary children and their families reside. We want to make a special mention and Thank You to Mr. Saroeun Bou (partner of Bike for Education), Ms. Sothida (AP's Landlady's daughter) and Sally Meisenhelde (WIG member), in addition to sending our thanks to several other wonderful individuals and partners who donated their time, money and supplies for this effort. The pictures below show the many provisions and items that were welcomed by the families of our Beneficiary children.





Key Collaboration

We are incredibly grateful to "Golden Sea," AP's regular seafood supplier, which has continued to deliver their weekly donations of fish. These donations complement our meal packs program wonderfully and aid AP in meeting our goal to provide 1 nutritious meal per day, 5 days per week to 50 beneficiaries, during this crisis.
