As we work toward our goal of becoming a ChildSafe Alliance partner, the Aziza's Place Child Protection Officers, Ms. Chanphoumy Choeun and Dr. Theara Ngnet benefited from training with 3PC's Child Protection Officer, Mr. Seny Sen (right).

3PC Cambodia is a child protection program powered by Friends-International in collaboration with UNICEF and the Cambodian Ministry of Social Affairs, Veterans and Youth Rehabilitation (MoSVY).

This is the first time Aziza's Place has had a bi-lingual Child Protection Policy of this

calibre and we are grateful for the support and assistance from the experts at Friends International and 3PC as we strive toward becoming a ChildSafe Alliance partner.

Family collaboration is key to our success











Our Social Work & Community Engagement program is something we're very proud of at Aziza's Place. It provides a bridge between parents, the school and our centre in order to share progress, concerns, and to collaborate on valuable initiatives and solutions.

Key to this success is our regular monthly family assemblies. They provide an opportunity to connect in a relaxed and transparent environment. And the chance to provide a monthly supply of rice and a mix of basic household necessities.

We value the time to discuss new initiatives and ways we can continue to support our families and communities. We also raise awareness of the importance of education, particularly for girls, and the creation of a safe and nurturing home environment.

We're going GREEN



It's Plastic Free July around the world and also in Cambodia, and we are raising awareness about the importance of contributing to a sustainable environment by going GREEN at Aziza's Place.

We are changing some of our small, daily habits like using re-useable drink bottles and a water dispenser using filters instead of plastic. And we're going to use our lovely garden to understand more about composting and recycling.





Helping us learn more about our contribution to a sustainable environmental were our friends Pamela Buck and her daughters, Isabella and Scarlett. Pam is a clinical psychologist who conducted mindfulness training with AP staff and, with her daughters, helped guide us on how to sort all our recyclable material. We will give the plastic and cardboard to those AP families who depend on selling it for their livelihood.

Please meet Yoeun Srey Sros. She came to Aziza's Place in 2007. Last year Srey Sros graduated from High School and is now in Year 1 at the National Institute of Social Affairs studying Sociology. She also works at Digital Divided Data.





This is Von Naween. At Aziza's Place since 2011 he has graduated from secondary to high school and is about to start Grade 11 in the new school year.





Introducing Chhorn Srey Phea, who joined Aziza's Place in 2008 and graduated from high school in 2018. However, she deferred her entrance to university for one year to train with the Cambodian National Karate team and compete successfully in regional tournaments.



New partnerships and collaborations

Krama Yoga is Cambodia's longest running public yoga studio, run by young men and women who have changed their



lives with yoga. We've partnered with them to provide monthly yoga classes to Aziza's Place children to encourage the development of emotional and mental health.



International Medical Relief provides mobile medical clinics and sustainable health education to underserved communities in 57 countries around the world.



Shanty Town Spirit extends education, hygiene and healthcare support to impoverished children and their families in the Boeung Trabek slum area in Phnom Penh.



The purpose of the guild is to assist children in vulnerable situations an/or mother care programs around the world and to serve as a mutual bond and centre of interest for women connected with the United Nations organisations.

PNN TV is a local TV channel broadcasting locally produced content that reflects the lifestyles of Cambodians today. Programs include game shows, variety shows, talk shows and news.





Brien Holden Vision Insititute is a social enterprise that develops new solutions for vision care, especially refractive error, and works to eliminate vision impairment, thereby improving quality of life for people in need and helping to reduce disability and poverty.

Introducing Nora


